ORDER

For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, the Court ORDERS that:

- Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction or, in the Alternative, a Stay Pending Judicial Review is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART;
- 2. Defendants are preliminarily ENJOINED from enforcing the repeal of the definition of discrimination "[o]n the basis of sex" insofar as it includes "discrimination on the basis of . . . sex stereotyping," as previously set forth in 45 C.F.R. § 92.4;
- Defendants are preliminarily ENJOINED from enforcing the 2020 Rule's incorporation of the religious exemption contained in Title IX, see 45 C.F.R. § 92.6(b); and
- 4. Plaintiffs' Motion is DENIED in all other respects.
