Fiscal Year 2016 Report on Conferences Sponsored by HRSA

About the Report:

This report is submitted as required by Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Memorandum on Promoting Efficient Spending to Support Agency Operations (M-12-12), dated May 11, 2012, which requires Federal agencies to publicly report, by January 31 of each year, all conferences hosted or sponsored by the agency during the previous fiscal year where the net expenses were in excess of \$100,000.

As the primary Federal agency for improving health and achieving health equity through access to quality services, the Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA) programs provide healthcare to people who are geographically isolated and economically or medically vulnerable. Protecting the public health and providing essential human services to the American people, effective outreach to our partners, grantees and to the public is central to the mission of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). The Agency's support to and attendance at a range of scientific, medical, and service-related conferences is critical for HRSA staff to engage stakeholders regarding HRSA's mission and to share our findings with our partners, grantees, and the public.

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB) hosted the 2016 National Ryan White Conference titled *Forward Momentum: Accelerating Access, Optimizing Care, and Transforming Public Health*.

How the conference advanced the mission of the agency and management rational for approval:

The conference provided significant opportunity for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program recipients to meet together and share best practices to improve health outcomes for people living with HIV, which results in significantly reduced transmission of HIV. Participants heard from national leaders regarding the status of the HIV epidemic, scientific advancements that impact the HIV epidemic, and the collective federal, state, local, and individual efforts to address the HIV epidemic. The National Ryan White Conference on HIV Care & Treatment delivered program and policy updates, training, and technical assistance to Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) recipients, people living with HIV, stakeholders, and health care and service delivery providers.
