#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Background:** The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is for PECOS to send ViPS Medicare System (VMS) the new Child Record 13 export file and for PECOS to receive and import the data from the import file from the ViPS Medicare System (VMS). In addition, the PECOS user interface will be updated to collect the required VMS claims fields and to create an Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Tab that will allow DME Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) Users access to PECOS in order to add or update EFT information. The DME MACs will update their PECOS user accounts with new user roles that allow access to the new EFT Tab. ViPS Medicare System (VMS) will send a test import file to Contractor for Government and Industries (CGI) no later than October 7, 2021. CGI will send the test Child Record 13 file to VMS no later than October 8, 2021. VMS will send the User Acceptance Testing (UAT) import file to CGI no later than October 18, 2021 and the production import file no later than December 29, 2021. CGI will provide the MACs an "Invalid EFT Report" containing all records that were not imported into PECOS from VMS prior to UAT and after the production release. The MACs will abstain from entering new data or updating existing data in PECOS and VMS from December 29, 2021 to January 2, 2022. PECOS will not send any extract files to VMS during this same time period to maintain data integrity between the two systems. PECOS will send the first updated VMS Extract File, including child record 13 where appropriate, on January 3, 2022. VMS shall not process or reprocess any PECOS Extract files generated before January 3, 2022 after the production release.
  - The Test import file (no later than October 7) is a dummy test file with the defined VMS Import file structure filled with the dummy data. CGI will use this test import file to start working on the code for import file processing logic.
  - The Test Child Record 13 Extract File (no later than October 8) is a dummy test file with the defined Child Record 13 structure filled with the dummy data. VMS will use this test import file to ensure they will be able to process the file and the data within.
  - The VMS EFT Import file from PROD (October 18) is the EFT import file generated from VMS Production database, which contains EFT data that needs to be migrated to the PECOS database. CGI needs this VMS EFT production import file to
