

**Congressional District Breakdown:
Delivery of Initial \$30 Billion of CARES Act
Public Health and Social Services Emergency Fund**

The Congressional district breakdown lists the amount allocated for billing organizations for eligible recipients based on the billing organization's address, not necessarily the congressional district where providers are operating. For example, a hospital system operating across a state may have received a lump sum to the billing organization located in one congressional district, whereas the providers are operating across several districts. This document shows breakdowns of the amounts allotted; it does not indicate whether a provider accepted or rejected the funds.
