

# International Harmonization of Accreditation Standards

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## Accreditation

Comprehensive external peer review designed to examine veterinary medical education programs for quality assurance and quality improvement

 evaluates the program to determine if it meets acceptable levels of quality and has a process for continuous quality improvement



- Formed (2007) to facilitate, manage and make recommendations on joint international accreditation site visits
  - Initial members
    - Australasian Veterinary Boards Council (AVBC)
    - American Veterinary Medical Association Council on Education (AVMA COE)
    - Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons
  - 2018 added
    - European Association for Establishments of Veterinary Education (EAEVE)
    - South African Veterinary Council



#### IAWG

- Does not function as a decision making body
- Does develop recommendations

#### Joint site visits

Developed procedures for joint site visits



#### Harmonization of Accreditation Standards

- Similarities and differences in accreditation standards
- Discussions on harmonization
- IAWG cannot mandate changes to accreditation standards
- Makes recommendations
- Each agency makes it own decision regarding changes to accreditation standards



- Standards and Antimicrobial Resistance
  - Limited mention in standards (AVBC, AVMA, EAEVE, RCVS)
  - In principle is covered in Curriculum and Outcome Assessment standards
  - Is in the RCVS and EAEVE Day 1 Competences
