

## **FY 2021 Funding Transfers and Referrals to the UC Program by Month**

October 8, 2021

P.L. 117-43 Extending Government Funding and Delivering Emergency Assistance Act includes a requirement to submit a report to Congress 10 days after enactment as described below:

*SEC. 144. Not later than 10 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall provide a report to the Committees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives and the Senate, and disclose on a publicly available website, on all transfers made for carrying out section 462 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 or section 235 of the William Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act of 2008 during fiscal year 2021. This report shall include: (1) a list of the source of funds transferred by public law;(2) the program, project, or activity funds were transferred from and the corresponding amount that was transferred;(3) date of transfer;(4) the number of children referred to the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) by month for fiscal year 2021; and(5) the age distribution of the children referred to ORR by month for fiscal year 2021: Provided, That the report shall be updated every 30 days throughout fiscal year 2022.*

### **FY 2021 Funding Transfers**

- Subsequent to the April 2, 2021 notification, \$287 million to the UC program from a reduction of an average of 0.3 percent and no more than 1 percent from discretionary appropriations across HHS (see Appendix for a list of accounts).
- Subsequent to the April 2, 2021 notification, \$850 million from Public Health and Social Services Emergency funding provided by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (P.L. 116-260) was transferred to the UC program to cover additional costs resulting from COVID-19.
- Subsequent to the July 2, 2021 notification, \$860 million from NIH funding provided by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (P.L. 116-260) was transferred to the UC program to cover additional costs resulting from COVID-19.
  - Of this amount, \$800 million was backfilled in FY 2021 and the remaining \$60 million will be backfilled in FY 2022.
- Subsequent to the August 17, 2021 notification indicating that up to \$225 million may be transferred to the UC program, \$203.5 million was transferred from NIH funding provided by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act to cover additional UC program costs resulting from COVID-19.
  - These funds will be backfilled in FY 2022.
