## Distribution of Health Professionals

Supporting health profession students in completing interprofessional clinical rotations and experiential training in rural and underserved communities

Clinical placements put health professions students in real world healthcare settings, working with underserved populations

## Practice Transformation

Providing continuing education and interprofessional training for practicing health professionals, in rural and underserved areas

Focus on team-based care, social determinants of health, cultural competency, behavioral health integration, new models of care and special health issues.
