

Over 1700 sites of care > 130 Medical Centers > 130 Long term care facilities








Largest Integrated Health Care System in US

 - Reporting and quality monitoring system established 2005










VHA's Antimicrobial Stewardship Initiative

- Highly active National Antimicrobial Stewardship Taskforce
- Engaged local stewardship champions
- Over half of all acute care VHA medical facilities are in process of enrollment or have submitted data to the NHSN Antimicrobial Use Option
