

VERIFIED WEIGHT REPORT

Instructions: If possible, officers should be evaluated by an active-duty commissioned officer from the United States Public Health Service or one of the other Uniformed Services. When unavailable, officers can be evaluated by an active-duty commissioned officer remotely (via live or recorded video) or by a federal employee non-officer adult in person. Officers may also be evaluated by their healthcare provider. The person evaluating the officer is referred to as the testing official. Enter whole numbers for height and body weight (round down for values 0.4 and lower and round up for values 0.5 or higher). Once complete, officer uploads the form to eDOC-U.
