## DETERMINATION TO DECLINE REVIEW OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE DECISION

After reviewing the record to evaluate the issues presented by James W. Marshall, Jr., D.O.'s exceptions to *James W. Marshall*, *D.O.*, ALJ Ruling No. 2017-9 (2017), we have determined that we need not render a separate decision. We therefore decline review of and summarily affirm ALJ Ruling No. 2017-9. Thus, that decision by the ALJ becomes final and binding 60 days from the date of service of this determination to decline review. *See* 42 C.F.R. § 1005.21(j).

Judicial review is available in an appropriate United States district court if a civil action is filed within 60 days after service of this determination to decline review. *See* sections 1128(f)(1) and 205(g) of the Social Security Act and 42 C.F.R. § 1005.21(k)(1).
