On May 28, 2021, President Joe Biden signed Executive Order 14031, establishing the White House Initiative on Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders.

In its first year, the Initiative collected action plans from 32 federal agencies, which collectively represent the Biden-Harris Administration's national strategy to advance equity, justice, and opportunity for Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander communities.
