Strategic Goals

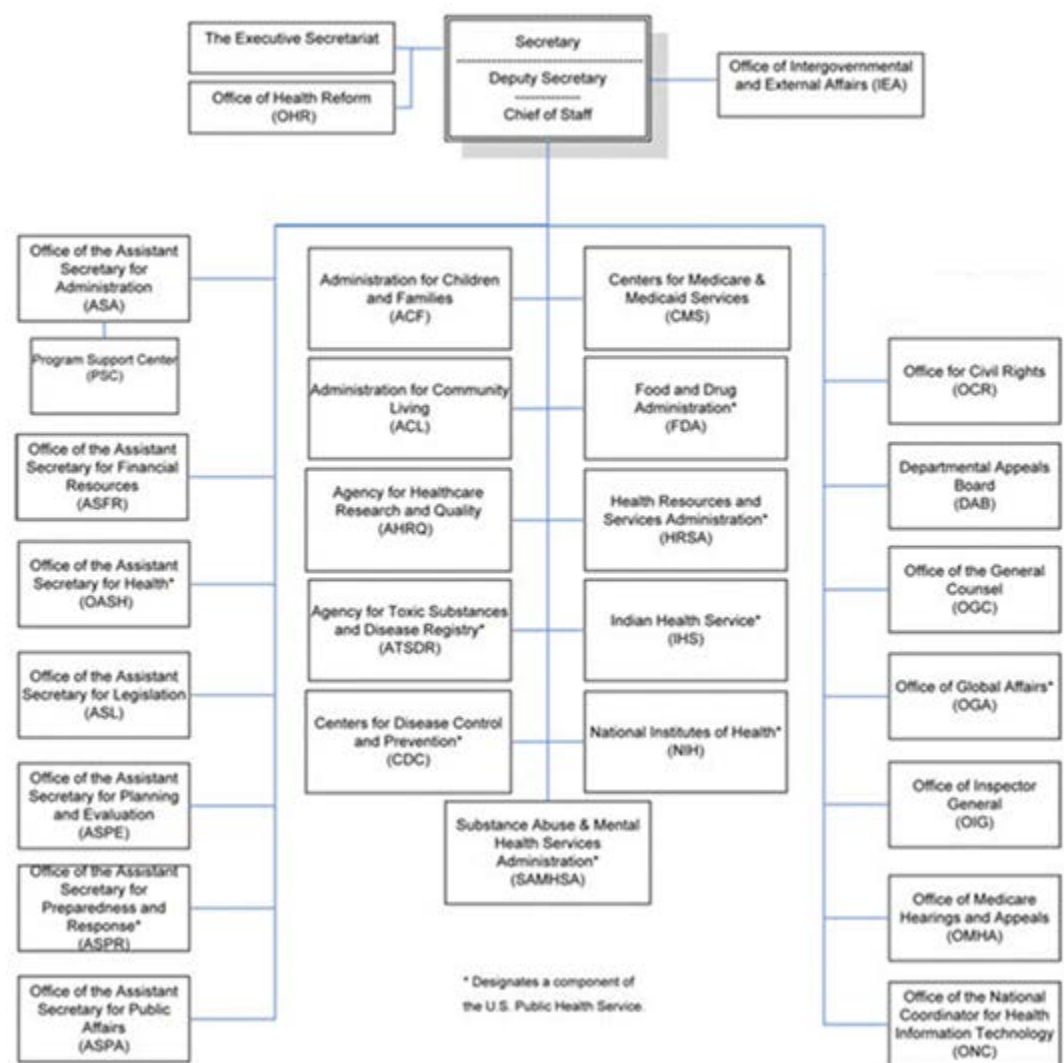

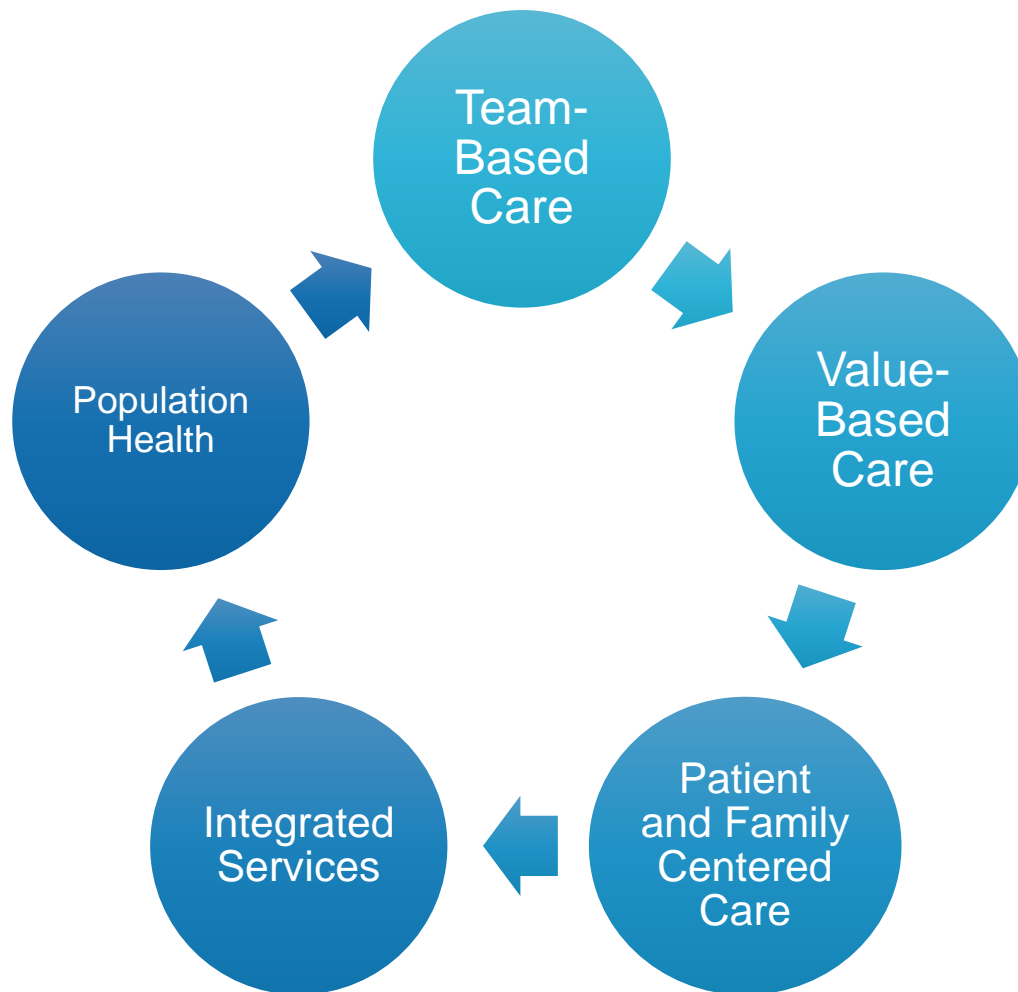
HHS Organization Chart



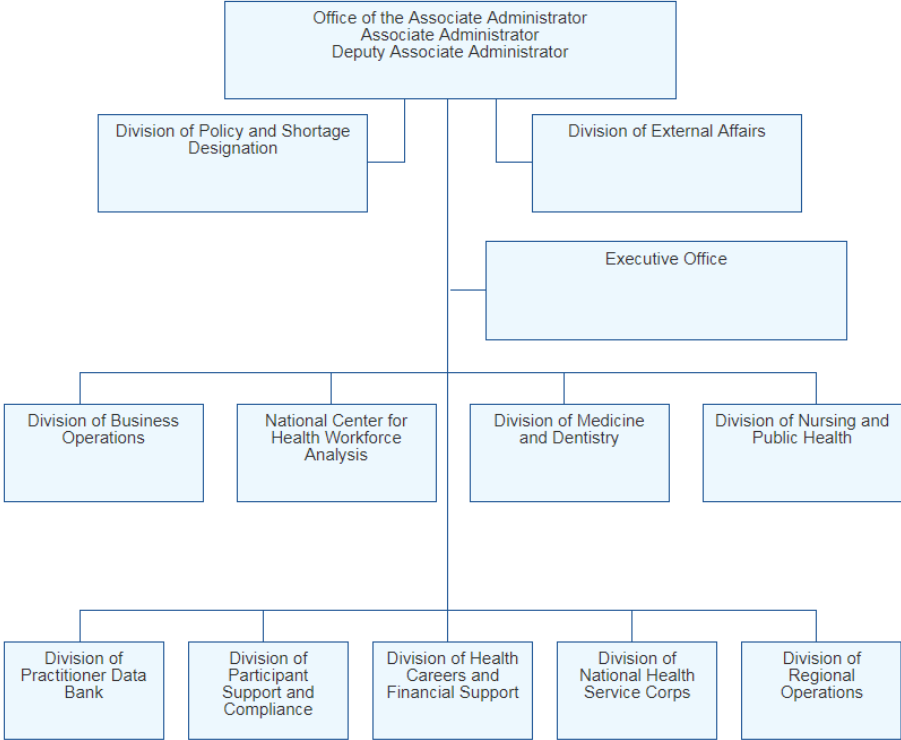

Federal Advisory Committees



Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA)

- Governs the establishment, operation and termination of advisory committees
 - Approximately 1,000 advisory committees
 - FACA Database (<https://facadatabase.gov/>)
- Requires openness and transparency
 - Federal Register Notice (FRN)
 - Provides opportunities for public comment

General FACA Requirements

- Develop and file a committee charter
- Hold open public meetings
 - Announce meetings in the Federal Register (15 days in advance of the meeting)
- Allow the public to submit written statements
- Publish minutes or summaries of meetings
- Maintain committee documents for public inspection

Advisory Committee on Interdisciplinary, Community-Based Linkages (ACICBL)

Provides advice and recommendations to:

1. HHS Secretary
2. Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (U.S. Senate)
3. Committee on Energy and Commerce (U.S. House of Representatives)



ACICBL

Provides advice and recommendations on:

- Policy and program development and other matters of significance concerning the activities under Title VII, Part D of the Public Health Service (PHS) Act
- Develop, publish and implement program performance measures
- Develop and publish guidelines for longitudinal evaluations of programs
- Recommend appropriation levels for programs in part D of Title VII



Structure

ACICBL membership:

- 16 members appointed by the Secretary
- Consist of health professionals from schools of the types described in Title VII sections 751(a)(1)(A), 751(a)(1)(B), 753(b), 754(3)(A), and 755(b) schools
- Special Government Employees

Structure

- Fair balance between the health professions
- At least 75% are health professionals
- Broad geographic representation of members including a balance of rural and urban members
- Adequate representation of women and minorities

Meeting

- Held no less than three times annually at the call of the DFO or designee who shall approve the agenda and be present at all meetings
- Conducted face-to-face or through teleconferencing or other distance based communications

Roles and Responsibilities:

- **Federal staff**
 - Designated Federal Official (DFO)
 - Advisory Committee Operations (ACO)
- **COGME Leadership**
 - Chair
 - Vice chair
- **Members**
 - Non-Federal
 - Federal



Roles and Responsibilities

- **Designated Federal Official (DFO)**

- Ensure compliance with FACA, and any other applicable laws and regulations
- Call, attend, and adjourn committee meetings
- Approve agendas
- Maintain required records on costs and membership
- Ensure efficient operations
- Maintain records for availability to the public (FACA Database, COGME website)
- May adjourn meeting when in public interest

Roles and Responsibilities

- **Chair**

- Participates in the development of meeting agendas
- Resides at all committee meetings and ensures that the agenda is closely adhered to
- Ensures all rules of order and conduct are maintained during each session
- Calls for a vote, if/when required
- Controls public participation during the open portion of a meeting
- Certifies to the accuracy of the minutes of each committee meeting prior to their distribution
- Works closely with the Advisory Council Operations Team

Roles and Responsibilities

- **Members**

- Attends scheduled meetings of the full committee
- Reviews required material before meetings
- Reads and understands provisions related to conflict of interest, ethics, and confidentiality and, as appropriate, completes necessary forms relating to these areas
- Completes necessary paperwork to ensure ethics requirements and compensation for his/her duties (e.g. submit original travel receipts)
- Participates in development of committee recommendations and reports

Advisory Committee Operations

- Creates efficient, consistent and streamlined processes across Bureau of Health Workforce Advisory Committees (AC)
- Coordinates and manages all AC public meeting logistics
- Maintains AC charters
- Serves as liaison for ethics, human resources, contracting and communications
- Coordinates Annual Committee Report (ACR) process for BHW Committees
- Coordinates ACICBL members travel

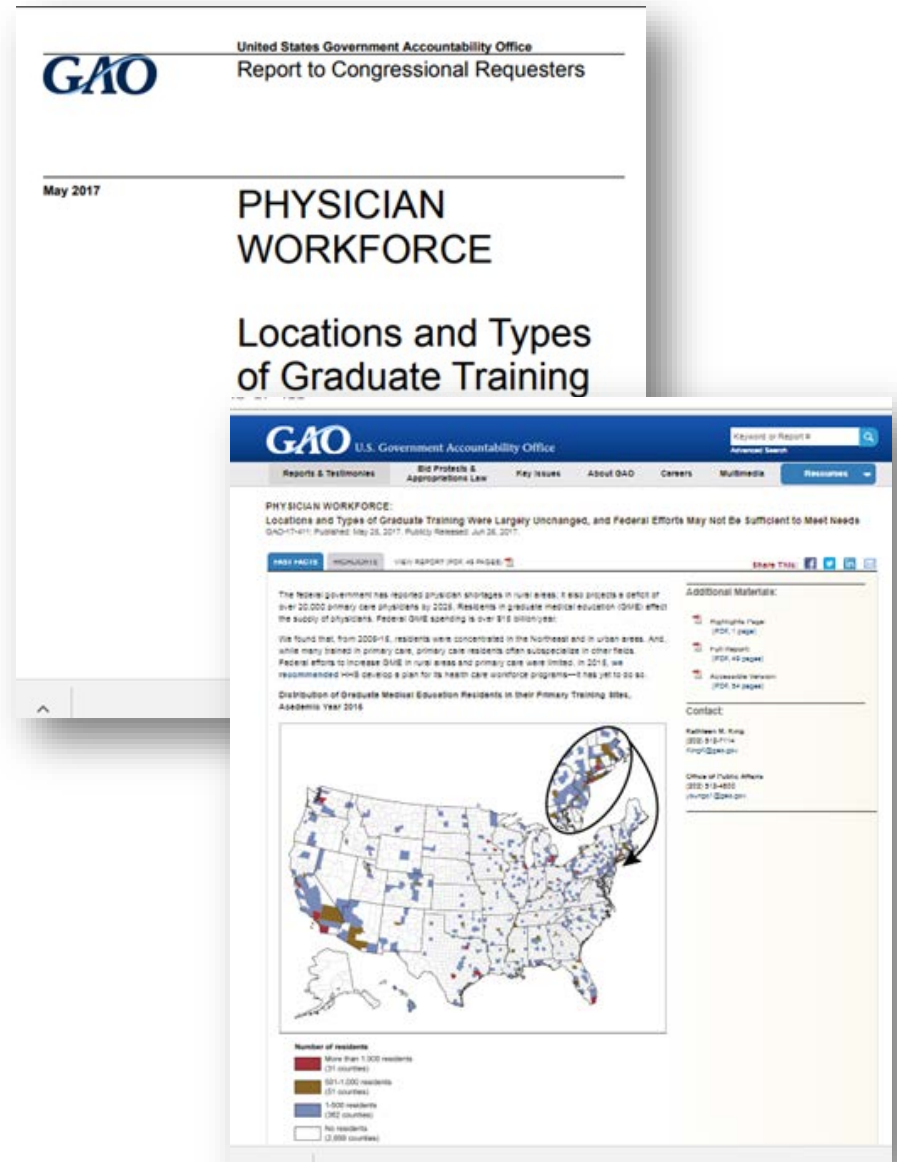

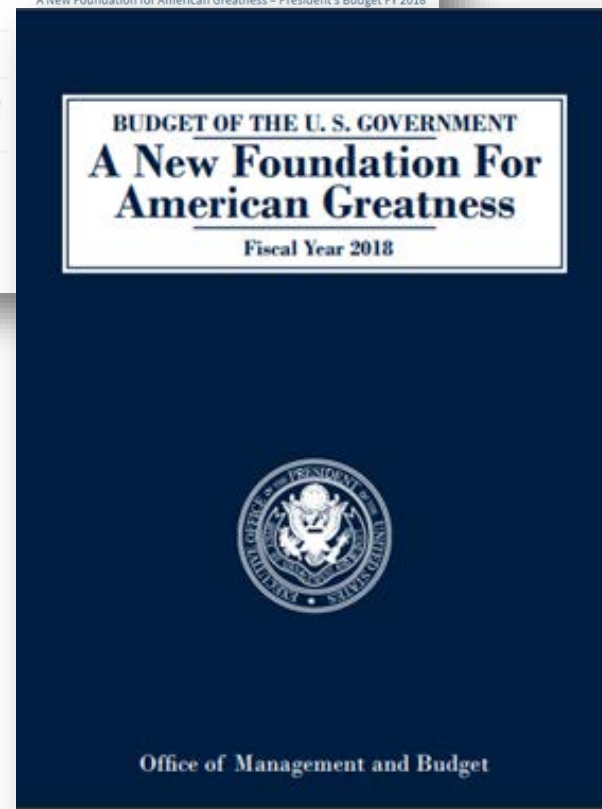
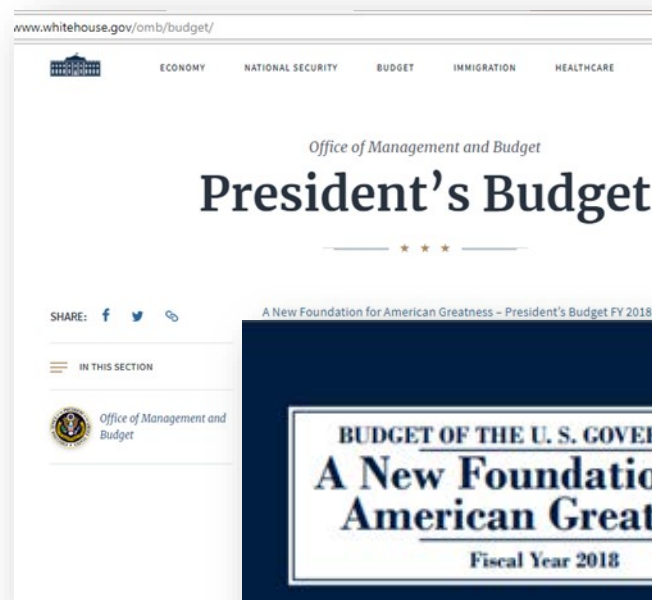
- An independent, nonpartisan agency that works for Congress

Internal Budget Review	May	The Department issues internal guidance
	June	Offices submit preliminary budget requests and legislative proposals
	July	Internal budget discussions and final agency decisions by Secretary
	August	Prepare the budget submission to OMB
OMB and President's Budget Review	September	Budget request submitted for OMB
	October	OMB conducts hearings and reviews the budget request
	November—December	OMB Passback and final decisions on appeals
