

Pledge to Reduce Prematurity by 8% by 2014



National CollIN Rollout

- ▶ Working with Region IV/VI on sustainability as their CollIN transitions to the next phase
- ▶ Supporting Region V's early elective deliveries team
- ▶ National Rollout July 21-22 (Regions VII-X),
July 24-25 (Regions I-III), August 24-25 (Region IX Territories)

ASTHO/UHF Learning Collaborative

- ▶ AR, GA, KS, OK, and RI received \$30,000 and TA
- ▶ Model/Theory: Institute for Healthcare Improvement's Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) cycles for rapid change.
- ▶ Project Period: May 2013-May 2014



Leveraged \$1M to support telemedicine

- All 159 Counties telehealth capable with reimbursement mechanisms
- Incorporating for Centering Pregnancy programs across state



Systematizing Text4Baby enrollment and follow-up process to tackle IM and Diabetes

- Including it in HIE
- Training for CHW

- ▶ Providing TA around QI and NBS system changes
- ▶ 6 state focus group planned (Fall 2014)

LARC Learning Community

- ▶ There are several barriers to the use of Long Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) , one of the most significant of which being out-of-pocket cost, insurance reimbursement, and unbundling of payment at birth.
- ▶ LARC Implementation Learning Community
 - 7 states: CA, CO, GA, IA, MA, NM, SC
 - Providing TA, state-to-state learning for implementing LARCs immediately post partum
 - Key informant interviews of challenges, successes
 - Capturing state stories, developing tools based on TA
