Do you have health insurance coverage? Among adults aged 18 and older



## **Coverage for Medicaid Expansion Population**

- Ten essential health benefit categories:
  - ambulatory patient services;
  - emergency services;
  - hospitalization;
  - maternity and newborn care;
  - mental health and substance use disorder services, including behavioral health treatment;
  - prescription drugs;
  - rehabilitative and habilitative services and devices; laboratory services;
  - preventive and wellness services and chronic disease management;
  - pediatric services, including oral and vision care.
- EPSDT for adults under age 21
- FQHC/RHC services
- Non-emergency medical transportation
- Free choice of family planning providers
- Mental health parity applies
- State may supplement EHB package with "traditional" coverage
- Medically frail adults receive traditional Medicaid
