In Western New York

If you are an adult with intellectual/developmental disability (IDD) who needs dental care...

- 14 week wait for a clinic visit
- 18 month wait for treatment under general anesthesia





Overview


- Burden of dental disease is higher
 - Untreated dental caries in 32.2% of patients with IDD
 - Edentulism in 7.6% of patients with IDD
- Graduating dental students are not confident or willing to treat patients with special needs, per graduates report
- Medicaid/3rd party insurers are the primary payers for people with IDD, with exceptionally low reimbursement rates
- Insufficient number of dental providers accept Medicaid:
 43% of all practicing dentists



In Summary...

We have a large volume of patients who need specialized care

- Our providers do not feel competent or confident in treating these patients
- Very few providers accept federal dental insurance



HRSA Postdoctoral Training in General, Pediatric and Public Health Dentistry and Dental Hygiene

A step in the right direction



- 5 year award
 - Provider salaries
 - Support staff salaries
 - Equipment for new dental center
- Located within an interdisciplinary center
- Expansion and enhancement of dental resident/student training



Triumphs

- Increase in applications to residency program
- Hiring of resident graduates
 5 hires since 2019
- New dental center to open. January 2022
- Buy in from stakeholders
 - Dental students
 - Dental faculty
 - Hospital administration

Crisis of available operating room time


Reimbursement
