The Provider Relief Fund (PRF) Reporting Portal (<https://prfreporting.hrsa.gov>) opened on January 1, 2022 and will close on March 31, 2022 for Reporting Period 2. More reporting information can be found on the [Reporting and Auditing Webpage](#).

Reporting Period 2

<p>Deadline to Use Funds December 31, 2021</p>	<p>Payment Received Period (Payments Exceeding \$10,000 in Aggregate Received) From July 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020</p>	<p>Reporting Time Period January 1 to March 31, 2022</p>
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Deadline to Use Funds is the last date in which the recipient may use payments for eligible expenses, including services rendered, and lost revenues attributable to coronavirus.

Payment Received Period describes a specific time period when the recipient received one or more payments. The payment is considered received on the deposit date for automated clearing house (ACH) payments or the check cashed date.

Reporting Time Period describes when recipients must go into the Reporting Portal and report on the use of funds. Recipients who fail to report within the respective Reporting Time Period will be considered out of compliance with the PRF *Terms and Conditions*.
