


Infant Mortality 2008



- Improve preconception/interconception Health (Medicaid waivers)
- Reduce SIDS/SUIDS (Safe Sleep)
- Regionalize NICU Care







Other Regions: West Virginia

- January 1, 2011: All maternity service providers must use the WV Prenatal Risk Screening Instrument (WV Legislative Rule §64-97-5)
 - PRSI Tool: http://www.wvdhhr.org/mcfh/
- First Year: 50% of all WV pregnancies, 60% of maternity service providers without compensation or consequence
- Data will be used to address common risk factors and form public policy, practice changes

Recommendations

- Capitalize on common goals and strategies of multiple national initiatives
- Actively engage executive leadership from business, hospitals, health care providers, public health, Medicaid, insurance, associations, others
- Calculate true savings while improving care
- Continue to leverage partnerships
