
HUMANITARIAN RESPITE CENTER BABIES AT BORDERS

- Main migrant shelter in Rio Grande Valley
- *Families seeking asylum, directly from CBP or ICE
- ❖Impact of "Remain in Mexico" policy
- Funded by Every Mother Counts, UNICEF, Community for Children
- 413 mothers (pregnant, newly postpartum) & 50 infants in 2020
- Clinical evaluation, social history, referral
- Enroll in Migrant Clinicians Network (MCN)



SEEKING ASYLUM

- Family/friends murdered by gangs
- ❖Intimate Partner Violence
- Pregnancy result of rape
- Harassment/extortion/death threats
- Kidnappings
- Poverty and lack of opportunity
- *Destruction from natural disaster
- Reunification with family members


HEALTH STATUS

- ❖Insufficient care or no care at all
- **❖**Low (health) literacy
- UTIs and vaginal infections
- Threatened preterm labor after journey
- Postpartum blood pressure issues
- Risk factors for depression/anxiety/PTSD
- Fear of seeking care due to legal status
- Very high risk of COVID exposure



BORDER POLICY ACTIONS

- End separation at border from father of baby
- *Accept ALL pregnant mothers at border
- Stop CBP from confiscating meds and MRs
- Clinicians & therapists/counselors in all shelters



POLICY IMPACTING ACCESS TO CARE

- ❖lmmediate entry into healthcare system at border
- ❖Networking/support systems like MCN
- Allow FQHCs to accept all prenatal patients
- Expand CHIP and Medicaid
- More robust routine postpartum care
- Contraception access & coverage







SUCCESSFUL PROGRAM MODELS


- Migrant Clinicians Network
