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HHS Role in the VICP



- Administers the VICP
- Reviews the claim
- Reviews the medical and scientific literature
- Determines if claim meets the medical criteria for compensation
- Makes a preliminary recommendation regarding the HHS Secretary's position to the Department of Justice

HHS Role in the VICP




- Provides Court-ordered compensation payments to petitioners
- Provides Court-ordered payments to attorneys

Increase in Filed Claims



 Since 2005, the number of claims filed with the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program has increased significantly.





HRSA VICP Staffing Levels (FTEs) Health Resources and Services Administration


