#### Well Woman Health Care

- With passage of the Affordable Care Act, well woman health care, preconception health, reproductive health and prenatal care are covered benefits
- Effectively, THIS ACT, is an investment in women's health AND new born health...

# Investment in Infant Outcomes requires an investment in Women's Health and Maternal Outcomes



#### Infant mortality has faired better than Maternal Mortality:

Maternal mortality in the US is 2-3 times higher than in western European Nations, Japan, Canada and Australia

But we must invest in maternal outcomes if we hope to improve neonatal outcomes

- Severe Maternal Morbidity currently impacts over 50,000 women annually
  - This represents an increase of 75% over the last decade
  - Postpartum hospitalizations doubled
  - Postpartum Mortality in the same decade doubled

And, the complications to mother are often accompanied by complications to the newborn, including prematurity

#### The National Agenda

- Address Reproductive Choice: Every Pregnancy is a Planned Pregnancy
- Address Obesity: weight gain DURING pregnancy and weight loss AFTER pregnancy.
- Address the Post Partum Visit: 70 percent of women conceive again
- Address the Health of Women BEFORE conception: particularly with Chronic Conditions Management Programs
  - Set quality measures SPECIFICALLY for women of reproductive age, with goals different than other individuals with chronic medical conditions



#### You Get What You Measure

- And we have NEVER measured health plans in terms of preconception health
- We have NEVER measured health plans and set women of reproductive age in a category separate from all others
- We have NEVER measured health plans in terms of teratogen use at the time of conception
- We have NEVER focused on women of reproductive age who have chronic medical conditions: Diabetes, Hypertension, Obesity
