# Title VII, Section 748 of the PHSA

- Authorizes programs to support and develop education and training programs in general, pediatric, and public health dentistry to include programs for student financial assistance, traineeships, faculty development, and preand post-doctoral training, as well as the establishment or operation of a faculty loan repayment program.
- Eight Funding Priorities
- All grants must be 5 years in duration





Accredited dental or dental hygiene schools, not-for-profit hospitals, or other public or private not-for profit entities that have accredited training programs in general dentistry, pediatric dentistry, or dental public health.

### **Oral Health Branch**

  - 2015 \$33.928M
  - 2014 \$31.928M





### **FY2018 Appropriations**

### • \$40.673M

### • Specific Language:

- Not less than \$10M for General Dentistry Programs and not less than \$10M for Pediatric Dentistry
- Not less than \$2,000,000 for the Dental Faculty Loan Repayment Program
- Issue a new funding opportunity for DFLRP

# **Predoctoral Training**

• Purpose

#### • Focus Areas:

- Support integration within the broader health care delivery system
- Support OH providers practicing in advanced roles
- Enhance clinical pediatric training for children 0-5 years (2017 awardees only)
- 25 Grants
- FY 2017: \$8,325,549
- AY 2016-17: trained 5,291 dental and dental hygiene students (less 2017 award)





### **Postdoctoral Training**

- Background
- Purpose
- Focus Areas:
  - Develop new training and delivery models in clinical training sites
  - Develop new or enhanced training in DPH or population health management
- 20 Grants
- FY 2017: \$10,055,974
- AY 2016-17: trained 460 dental residents





### Dental Faculty Development and Loan Repayment Program

- Purpose
- Requirements for Loan Repayment Recipients
- Faculty Development
- Program Requirements
- Nine Grants
- FY 2017: \$2,084,022
- AY 2016-17: 14\* dental faculty members





### **Dental Faculty Loan Repayment Program**

- Purpose
- No Faculty Development requirement
- Program Requirements
  - Pediatric Dentistry Preference (2017 only)
- NEW 2018 Funding Competition
- 10 Grants
- FY 2017: \$884,922
- No performance level data available





### Primary Care Clinician Educator Career Development Awards

- Combined 2017 competition with PCTE
- Purpose
- Six grants (up to \$200K annually)
- Five dental school, one medical school faculty
- FY 2017: \$1,152,702 (dental only)
- No performance level data available
