- Establish, maintain, or improve academic units or programs

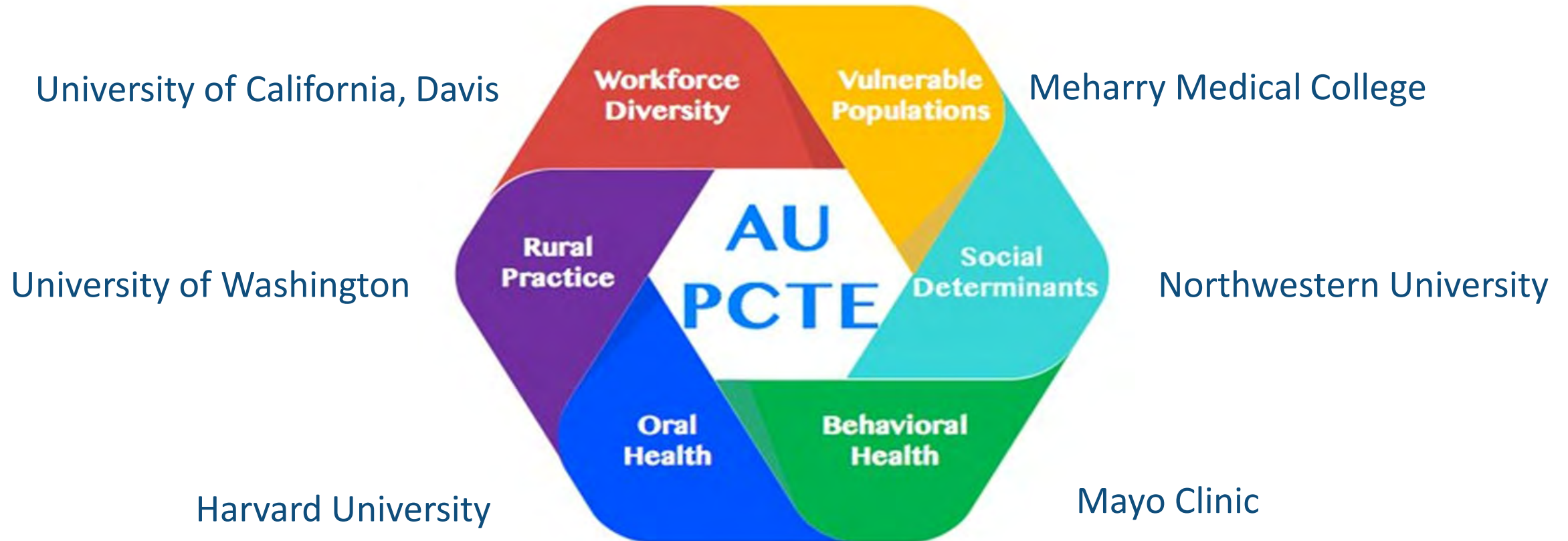
Requirements for AU-PCTE Awardees-
