Average annual number of petitions filed during FY 2011-2015 = 545



DICP Update Vaccine Injury Compensation Trust Fund

- Total Income: \$224,789,797
- Interest as a Percentage of Total Income 27%

DICP Update Recent Trends

- 90% of petitions were filed for adults in the last 2 fiscal years
- Over 54% of petitions filed in the last 2 fiscal years allege shoulder injury related to vaccine administration (SIRVA)
- 73% of petitions filed in the last 2 fiscal years allege an injury from the influenza vaccine
- About 70% of petitions filed are compensated via negotiated settlement since FY 2006 (56% in FY 2019)
- Nearly a 13-month wait for petitions to be reviewed by a HRSA physician
