As of the end of Fiscal Year 2021, 35 tribal and urban Indian health centers are dually-funded meaning they receive both Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Health Center Program and Indian Health Service (IHS) funding. IHS provides funds to federally recognized tribes or tribal organizations under the Indian Self-Determination Act and to Urban Indian organizations under the Indian Health Care Improvement Act to operate health centers serving American Indian/Alaska Native patients and other underserved populations.
