# March 2019: EAP Meeting

- Expert Advisory Panel met to discuss the ACHDNC's condition review process
- Four focus areas
  - Nomination
  - **Systematic Evidence-based Review**
  - Decision Matrix
  - Review of Current Conditions on the RUSP

# Timeline

- **April 2019:** Systematic evidence review
- **August 2019:** Values, cost assessment, population-level modeling, public health system assessment
- **November 2019:** Decision matrix and review of conditions on the RUSP
- **February 2020:** Initial nomination package; confirm final changes to the process

# Goals for Today Continued

## ■ Systematic Evidence Review Topics

- Case definitions at the start of the review process and the need to standardize terminology regarding primary and secondary targets and incidental findings
- Pre-specifying outcomes and the use of intermediate outcomes (e.g., biomarkers)
- Range of treatments that should be included
- Grading the evidence
- Identifying and synthesizing unpublished evidence/data
