- "As necessary, standing and ad hoc subcommittees composed of members of the parent committee may be established to perform specific functions within the Committee's jurisdiction."

Proposed Charge of Subcommittee

- Define and implement a mechanisms for the periodic review and assessment of
 - the conditions included in the uniform panel
 - infrastructure services needed for effective and efficient screening of the conditions included in the uniform panel
 - laboratory procedures utilized for effective and efficient testing of the conditions included in the uniform panel

Periodic Review and Assessment of the Conditions Included in the Uniform Panel —

- Identify the criteria to be used by the committee in recommending inclusion of a new condition in the uniform panel, and define the type of evidence that the subcommittee will utilize in making decisions
- Establish ad hoc working groups comprised of people with the necessary expertise to evaluate tests, technologies and benefits to the individual and society
- Complete timely reviews
- Provide assessment(s) to the Advisory Committee for consideration

Infrastructure Services Needed for Effective and Efficient Screening of the Conditions Included in the Uniform Panel

- Examples: Sample collection, sample transport, result reporting to physicians and families, and referral for confirmation of diagnosis and counseling
- Establish a working group comprised of people with the necessary expertise to evaluate infrastructure services
- Complete timely reviews
- Provide assessment(s) to the Advisory Committee for consideration

Laboratory Procedures Utilized for Effective and Efficient Testing of the Conditions Included in the Uniform Panel

- Establish a working group comprised of people with the necessary expertise to evaluate laboratory procedures, including nomenclature, testing strategies, cut-off values, reporting requirements, performance metrics, and case definitions.
- Complete timely reviews
- Provide assessment(s) to the Advisory Committee for consideration.
