- HRSA funded project to improve communication of MS: MS screening results
 - Better communication of risk
 - Improved prediction
- Development of improved markers incorporating multiple analytes (VLCAD example)
- Expanded pilot with MA, NY, WI, and CT

Molecular Screening for SMA

- Challenges
 - Must account for multiple allelic configurations
 - SMN1 deletions are pathologic but SMN2 status is predictive
- Multiplex PCR based, DNA melting technique
- Can also multiplex with TRECs

- Identify key quality measures currently followed by state screening programs
- Establish quality measures to capture for laboratory systems long term follow up
- Use for national IS purposes
- Very short time line to convene a working group and create a report (July)
- Will involve NLM

NLM Report

- New codes for Hb reporting from Hb workgroup (multiple levels of reporting)
