# **NGS/NSIGHT** Inspired Discussion

- Discussion of non-newborn/childhood testing could the committee play a role?
- When is there another time to have all children tested (audience capture) if it's a public health activity?
- Discussion of guidelines for laboratories using old data e.g. hemoglobinopathies, DNA raw data 20 years from now
- Discard data liability issue? Cheaper to re-test? Best practices?
- Software compatibility

### Wednesday's vote on 1 prospective case

- One proposal for a matrix nomination process
  - Discussion of frequency of the condition vs. cost of screening
  - It will be harder when conditions are more rare, but we can't lower the bar
- Laboratorians are used to a process, removing subjectivity from the process
- Don't bypass the follow-up piece of the process

### Timeliness – impact of molecular testing

- Adding NGS and other second tier tests adds time to testing
- May impact ability to meet the timeliness recommendations
  - Revisit the recommendations as we get real data?
- States sharing molecular resources could help with timeliness, \$ issues with adopting new technology
- If we get to the diagnosis faster, then you've made an improvement in timeliness

### Timeliness – preanalytic issues

- Quality of DBS and timeliness of collection and transit still an issue
- Turnover at hospitals still a major issue new staff is not being trained on collecting a good DBS, etc. Members report a variable level of improvement and maintenance of timeliness in their relationships with hospitals.
- Need a champion in each facility
- Hiring a courier service is still a \$\$ issue and some couriers still aren't timely with shipping
- Need a role of Joint Commission
- Transparent timeliness data available to the public
