












Postgraduate Community-Based Training



Training Sites by Setting and Academic Year


■ MUC ■ Primary Care ■ Rural



Strategies to Address Community Needs

- Leverage the community health worker program and other HRSA community-based partners to expand the pipeline of HRSA-supported community members entering the health professions













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
